To Whom It May Concern:

The Erosion and Sediment Control Plans for the above-mentioned project have been approved by the Thomas Jefferson Soil and Water Conservation District.

Prior to beginning any land disturbing activities you must be issued a Land Disturbing Permit by Louisa County. The following is required in order for this permit to be issued and must be received by the Community Development Office prior to scheduling the pre-construction meeting:

- 1) Adequate security for implementation of the Plans must be submitted. The amount of security for this project has been set at \$332,009.00 and may be posted in the form of a performance bond, letter of credit or cash escrow.
- 2) A pre-construction conference must be held with the owner/developer, the contractor and the Louisa County Code Enforcement Officer.
- 3) The owner must supply the County with the name of the individual who will be in charge of and responsible for land disturbing activities on this project. This person must hold a **"Responsible Land Disturber Certificate"** from the Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation.
- 4) Copy of the entrance permit from the Virginia Department of Transportation (if applicable).
- 5) Copy of the Virginia Stormwater Management Permit issued by the Commonwealth of Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation for land disturbance exceeding one acre (if applicable).

Once this bond has been received and approved, and the pre-construction conference held, the Land Disturbing Permit will be issued. You must post the hard copy of the permit on the site and then you may begin land-disturbing activities.
