Fred G. Wood III is senior vice president–Financial Management for Dominion Generation.

He is responsible for the financial management of Dominion’s generating business, which includes approximately 28,000 megawatts of nuclear, fossil & hydro and renewable generation in 10 states.

Wood joined the company in 1985 as an economist with Virginia Power. Since then, he has held numerous senior management financial positions, including assistant vice president and assistant treasurer of Dominion Resources from 1996 to 1998; he also was in charge of investor relations from 1997 to 1998. He served as vice president, treasurer and chief financial officer of Dominion Energy from 1998 to 2000, and as senior vice president–Financial Management for Dominion Exploration & Production from 2000 to 2004. He was named to his current position in January 2004.



Mr. Wood serves on the Business Partner’s Board of the College of William & Mary’s Mason School of Business.

A native of Charlottesville, Va., Wood received a bachelor’s degree in economics from the College of William & Mary and a master’s degree in economics from Virginia Commonwealth University.
